Hello, I am Kailyn McNamee or to your child I am known as Ms. McNamee. Welcome to third grade! I hope you all had a relaxing, yet eventful summer. I am so excited to have your child in my classroom this year. This is my third-year teaching at Gideon. This will be my second year teaching third grade. Teaching third-grade has always been a goal of mine since I was in high school.

I graduated in 2019 from Holy Family University with a bachelor's degree in Early Education and Special Education. I am currently in school to receive my Master's Degree. Although this is my third year at Gideon, I have been teaching for six years.

I will be using PBIS Rewards as an incentive in the classroom and as a form of communication with parents. The bell schedule for Gideon is 9:00-3:39. Students will be marked tardy after 9:15. The first day of school, I will be sending out an emergency contact form, transportation to school (where you explain who can pick your child up and how) and a permission slip indicating whether your child can walk home alone or not.

Homework will be given every night Monday through Thursday. I will be having the students write their homework in a composition book. Please make sure to read through their homework book every night to check for homework. Included is a list of supplies your child will need for third grade. Communication folders will be given every Wednesday with information. Please make sure the folder gets returned Thursday.
